AUDIO AND VIDEOTAPING RULES FOR MEETINGS OF THE VILLAGES OF BONITA BOARD, MEMBERS, AND COMMITTEES.

Complying with the Florida Statutes, the Villages of Bonita Master Association adopts the following rules regarding videotaping and recording at Meetings of the Board, Members, and Committees:

- 1. Any member may tape record or videotape meetings of the Board of Directors, Committee Meetings or Membership Meetings, subject to the following restrictions:
 - a. The only audio and video equipment and devices, including mobile devices, which members are authorized to utilize at any such meeting is equipment that does not produce distracting sound or light emissions.
 - b. Video equipment shall be assembled and placed in position fifteen (15) minutes in advance of the commencement of the meeting. The placement location to be determined by the Board of Directors and/or Chair of Committee.
 - c. Any member videotaping or recording a meeting shall not be permitted to move about the meeting room.
 - d. Advance written notice of forty-eight (48) hours prior to commencement of the meeting shall be given to the Wendy Traiger, CAM at Gulf Breeze Management Services by a member desiring to utilize any audio or video equipment and devices, including mobile devices.
 - e. Any tapes or videos taken at a meeting may not be disseminated outside of the Villages of Bonita Master Association without the written consent of the Board of the Directors.
 - f. There shall be no audio or videotaping of meetings by a third party (non-member) without a written request and approval by the Board of Directors.
