Clubhouse & Pool Landscaping Update

The clubhouse and pool landscaping renovation project will begin on **Monday, April 6th**.

The pool will be closed on **Monday, April 6th** and will reopen on **Tuesday, April 7th**.

Landscapers will be in the pool area beginning **April 6th**. Please be kind and respectful as they work to enhance our community space.

FAQs

How long will the project take? 7–14 days, weather dependent.

Why is this work being done?

Many of the existing plants are 20–30 years old and have reached or exceeded their typical landscape lifespan. Replacing them will enhance the overall appearance, improve plant health, and support long-term sustainability.

Why now?

This is an ideal installation window in Southwest Florida. Temperatures are still moderate, allowing new plantings to establish before the intense summer heat. Completing the project now also ensures stronger root development ahead of rainy season. Additionally, the landscape committee will be actively available to monitor and support the new plantings during this critical period.

What about drought conditions?

A drip-line irrigation system will be installed to deliver water directly to the root zones, maximizing efficiency and minimizing waste. During the initial establishment period (the first several weeks), irrigation will be scheduled for consistent evening watering to support root development while reducing evaporation.

Will the pool be usable?

Yes, the pool will reopen on April 7th and remain open during the project, although workers will continue to be in the pool area during this time.

Will there be disruption? Some noise during working hours is expected.
